Trip report

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Itinerary

- 23th July : morning flight (Transavia) to Funchal , transfer to Camacha
- 24th July : daytrip Ponta de Sao Lourenco , afternoon Ponta do Garajau
- 25th July : Faya da Noguiera Ribeiro Frio Balcoes Pico do Areeiro Evening pelagic Venturo do Mar
- 26th July : Gabo Girao Calhete , evening Ponta do Garajau
- 27th July : Porto Moniz Ponta do Pargo
- 28th July : walked Pico do Areeiro Pico Ruivo , midnight excursion Zino's petrel

Marine mammals

Bryde's whale – *balaenoptera edeni*

- -1, evening trip Ventura
- -1, Desertas trip Ventura
- -1, Sea-Born trip

Obvious blow, erect and sickle-shaped dorsal, black colour, tailstock clearly arched before diving, no fluke. Bryde's whale is regular in this area, and non-migratory.

Short-finned pilot whale – *globicephala macrorhynchus* ->5, evening trip Ventura

Some mature males with bulbous head and very typical dorsal, travelling together with some 20 bottlenose dolphins. Great!

Common bottlenose dolphin – tursiops truncatus

-20, evening trip Ventura -35, Sea-Born trip

Excellent show, jumping and bow-riding !

Sea turtles

Loggerhead sea-turtle – *caretta caretta* -3 , Sea-Born trip

2 big-ones , 1 small , which was eventually caught , and set free again after taking pictures .

Reptiles

Madeira Lizard – *lacerta dugesii* -very common all over the place

Birds

Fea's petrel – *pterodroma feae deserta*

- -2, off Ponta de Sao Lourenco
- -23, seatrip Funchal Deserta Grande
- -1, off Funchal (Sea-Born trip)

Excellent views of the '*pterodroma*'s '; birds showed obvious M-mark on upperwing, thick bills and pointed wings; most birds had fairly dark underwings, except for the axillaries, but a few birds showed obvious white bars on the entire underwing. Not mentioned in the books, but obvious in the field, was the dark-hooded impression of the birds. Typical '*pterodroma*' with low flight, combined with high, bouncing arcs.

Highlight of this trip!

Zino's petrel – *pterodroma madeira*

-7 to 10, visiting their burrows on the famous Pico do Areeiro

Our visit to the breeding site was on a warm night, with hardly any wind. Birds arriving from 23.00 onwards, uttering their bizarre calls. Sometimes we could see the birds flying along the steep mountains. Allthough expensive (Euro 65,-), this is an experience not to be missed!

Bulwer's petrel – bulweria bulwerii

->300, off Funchal (Ventura trip) ->150, seatrip Funchal – Deserta Grande -1, on the nest / Deserta Grande -1, Porto Moniz -25, off Funchal (Sea-Born trip)

Stunning views, defenitely another birding-highlight!

Cory's shearwater – *calonectris borealis* -very common

From 22.00, you can listen (and see) the Cory's arriving at their burrows at Ponta do Garajau; great!

Manx shearwater – *puffinus puffinus* -1, Porto Moniz

Foraging in a group of Cory's shearwaters

Little egret – *egretta garzetta* -1 , Lugar de Baixo -1 , Machico

Eurasian sparrowhawk – *accipiter nisus granti* -2, Camacha area -female with young , near Monte

Common buzzard – *buteo buteo harteri* -regular

All birds were very dark-coloured

Common kestrel – *falco tinnunculus canariensis* -regular

Common coot – *fulica atra* -1 , Lugar de Baixo

Normally, said to be a winter-visitor

Common moorhen – *gallinula chloropus* -at least 2 pairs with young , Lugar de Baixo

Listed as an occasional visitor by Tony Clarke's Birds of the Atl. Islands Knot – calidris canutus -1 (summer-plumage), Funchal Scarce on passage Sanderling – calidris alba -1 (summer-plumage), Funchal Eurasian curluw – numenius arquata -1, Ponta do Pargo Turnstone – *arenaria interpres* -regular, Funchal, Machico Black-headed gull – *larus ridibundus* -1, moulting adult summer-winter, Machico Lesser black-backed gull – *larus fuscus* -Funchal Yellow-legged gull – larus michahellis atlantis -common, also birds foraging on insects at Paul da Serra Common tern – *sterna hirundo* -regular Turtle dove – *streptopelia turtur* -1 (adult), near Ponta do Pargo Trocaz pigeon – *columba trocaz* ->10, Faya da Noguiera -7, Ribeiro da Janela / Levada de Risco This endemic is common in the Laurel-forest. Nice views of flying and perched birds, both at Noguiera and Janela. At the Risco-waterfall, we saw at least 4 birds perched, one was even foraging on the path! Barn owl – *tyto alba schmitzi* -3, Funchal-jetty / old fortress -1, Ponta do Garajau The 3 birds at the Funchal-jetty were presumably begging juveniles, the one at Garajau was a hunting bird Plain swift – apus unicolor -common Obviously small, slender-winged; long + deeply-forked tail

Pallid swift *-apus pallidus* -2 , Lugar de Baixo

A rare breeder on Madeira

Barn swallow – *hirundo rustica* -1, near Ponta do Pargo

Berthelot's pipit – *anthus berthelotii madeirensis* -10, Ponta de Sao Lourenco -10, Pico do Areeiro

Grey wagtail – *motacilla cinerea schmitzi* -common

Robin – erithacus rubecula -garden-bird

Blackbird – *turdus merula cabrerae* -seen daily

Spectacled warbler – *sylvia conspicillata bella* -1 , Ponta do Garajau -2 , near Ponta do Pargo

Also, a rare breeder on Madeira

Blackcap – sylvia atricapilla heineken -very common

Madeira firecrest – *regulus madeirensis* -very common , many juveniles seen !

Spanish sparrow – *passer hispaniolensis* -10, Canical

Introduced

Rock sparrow – *petronia petronia madeirensis* -25, Ponta de Sao Lourenco

Canary – *serinus canaria* -common

Goldfinch – *carduelis carduelis parva* -common

Chaffinch – *fringilla coelebs madeirensis* -very common butterflies Small White – Pieris rapae -common

Clouded Yellow – *Colias croceus* -very common

Madeira Brimstone (Cleopatra) – *Gonepteryx maderensis* -1, Camacha

This one is rare!

Small Copper – *Lycaena phlaeas phlaeoides* -some 10 seen

Long-tailed Blue – *Lampides boeticus* -regular

Monarch – Danaus plexippus -seen daily in small numbers

Madeiran Grayling – *Hipparchia maderensis* -common around Pico do Areeiro

Speckled Wood – *Pararge aegeria aegeria* -very common

Madeiran Speckled Wood – *Pararge xiphia* -some 20 seen , several places

Scarce, probably due to competition with aegeria (?)

Dragonflies

Island darter – *sympetrum nigrifemur* -3 seen

Big sympetrum with mainly black legs ; the side of the thorax looks like *s. danea* i.e. having a broad black line with 3 enclosed spots.

Blue emperor – *anax imperator* -regular in our garden
